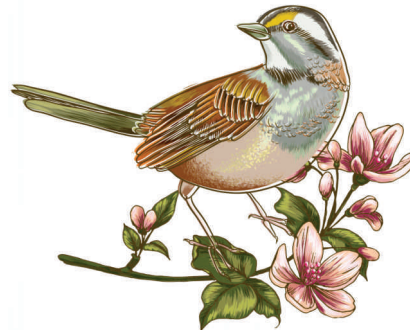


The Chaplain's Corner
