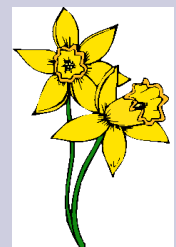

There were a number of Nobles and Ladies who were down with the flu, hopefully they will be feeling better by now.

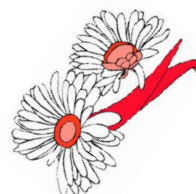
Thank you to Heather Brough who was our speaker for the evening. Heather spoke about the many things that her organization does in the community. You will see another write up in our newsletter.

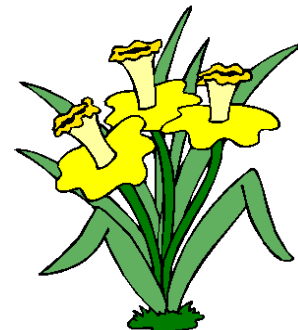
